



PhD ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Immediately following successful completion of comprehensive examinations, students must formally establish their PhD Advisory Committee. This will include the faculty member acting as the dissertation supervisor, and at least two other graduate faculty members. The Advisory Committee may have the same members as the Comprehensive Examination Committee or may have different members.

The School of Graduate Studies requires that each student in a doctoral program meet annually with a supervisory committee to assess the student's progress in the program and to provide advice on future work. Failure to submit annual reports and/or submission of consecutive unsatisfactory progress reports may be grounds for termination in the program.
